### How California's "Day of Rest" law applies to restaurant

A recent order by the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals clarified usage of the "day of rest" law in scheduling employees. Businesses can schedule workers up to twelve sequential days and still be in compliance with the law. A related decision prevents employees from substituting plaintiffs in an ongoing case against an employer for alleged "day of rest" violations.
