California Restaurants are Spared a Possible Pork Shortage - At Least For Now

Thanks to a legal battle led by the CRA, pork producers will get more time to prepare to comply with Proposition 12, an animal welfare law passed by voters in 2018. The state has been slow to issue final rules to pave the way for compliance with this law, which holds sellers of meat accountable if new rules aren't followed by meat producers. The judge ruled last week that restaurants, retailers, and grocers won't be subject to enforcement until 180 days after the state issues final regulations.



Protect The Franchise Model

The California State Assembly has passed AB 257, a bill strongly opposed by the CRA, the International Franchise Association, local business groups, and organizations who represent local government. The bill now heads to the State Senate.

"Supporters of this proposal want to divide franchisees from their workers and suggest we are in conflict. But the small business owners I know consider our crew and managers as part of our extended family. We are invested in their success and want to provide opportunities for our workers through work and education, perhaps to become a business owner themselves someday. And we care deeply about creating a safe and healthy worksite for them every day." – CC Yin, California franchisee


McDonald's to expand McPlant to about 600 U.S. stores in February


