San Francisco Drops Mask Mandate for Indoor Dining and Drinking on February 16

Most Bay Area counties are lifting their indoor mask mandates for the public, following in the footsteps of a recent state announcement. Restaurants can choose to continue to enforce their own mask policies if they wish, but many local governments are ending the mandate this week. Proof of vaccine requirements are still in place in some of the same counties. Cal OSHA's Emergency Temporary Standard must still be followed, which means mask mandates still apply for unvaccinated employees and for those exposed in an outbreak.
