Face Masks Are Required
Unless You are Fully Vaccinated



According to the California Department of Public Health, as of June 15, 2021, fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear face masks under certain circumstances. However, masks are still required for unvaccinated individuals in indoor public settings and businesses, including restaurants.
