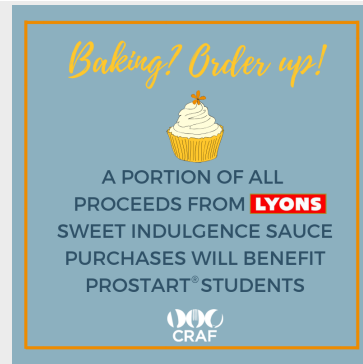

FDA and leafy green growers agree: romaine will now be labeled

Foodborne illness outbreaks seem to be more and more common. With the second E. coli contamination of romaine recently, the FDA has announced a voluntary leafy greens labeling program. Date of harvest and growing region will be included, helping to improve traceability and market recalls in the future. The most recent outbreak likely originated in California's Central Coast region, but it has not been definitively traced.
