

As a reminder, CalSavers is the stateadministered retirement plan for workers whose employers don't offer a 401K or other plan. As an employer, you don't have to offer a plan of your own, but you do have to register with CalSavers, make your employees aware of it, and facilitate the payroll deduction for those who wish to participate.
