



# News You Need to Know: The CRA joins lawsuit; attempts to avoid further restaurant supply chain disruption

The CRA and several other California trade associations have filed a lawsuit requesting state regulators delay implementation of new rules governing animal confinement. Those new rules must be followed by meat producers and are a result of Proposition 12, which was passed by California voters in 2018. It's not the law we take issue with - it's the unworkable delay by the state in finalizing new regulations to go with that law. This leaves meat producers unable to comply, and is sure to lead to a reduction in the supply of pork, and much higher prices for the product when it is available.
